American Politics: Donald Trump Found Guilty

- Donald Trump, former president of the United States, was found guilty on all 34 felony charges by a New York City jury, making him the first US President convicted of a felony. He was charged with falsifying business records and covering up a hush-money payment near the end of his 2016 presidential campaign. His sentencing will take place on July 11th.
- Trump's personal lawyer, Michael Cohen, paid \$130,000 to an adult film star, Stormy Daniels. Daniels had claimed to have had an affair with Trump years earlier. The money paid was to prevent the story from going public in fear that it would threaten the election.
- Trump has been indicted on 34 counts of falsifying business records in the first degree, in violation of Penal Law §175.10. The charges include 11 counts related to invoices, 12 counts related to ledger entries, and 11 counts related to checks. Trump could face up to four years in prison for this violation. However, probation is also an option.
- While Trump has been convicted, this will not stop him from running for president as there is no legal prohibition. However, depending on his probationary status Trump may be ineligible to vote come election day.

Global Events: Wildfires Rage Again in Canada

- Multiple wildfires in Canada forced thousands of people to flee and for the government to issue evacuation orders.
- For the second year in a row, Canada's wildfire season, which stretches from April to September or October, has experienced very active and rapid wildfires. The cause of this sudden intensity is said to be severe droughts and uncharacteristically warm weather due to global warming. These conditions may lead to more intense fires in the future.
- Despite a strand of cooler weather and the efforts of firefighters, the nation is still declaring a high wildfire level alert, and smoke is beginning to affect air quality.
- Should these fires continue, the smoke may travel to the US, as seen last year after Canada experienced the worst wildfire crisis in its history.
